YARD-SALE- GIVE AWAY 2022 SO MUCH HURT, YET SO MUCH HOPE

Saturday, May 14th was a beautiful, warm, sunny, and peaceful afternoon in Buffalo. In one of the poorest parts of the city, a lone gunman came into our community and entered into the Tops supermarket on Jefferson Ave (our only market in the community), and shattered our peace. Shooting and killing ten people, he thought he was destroying, but he actually brought our community together. Where he thought he

would kill the weak, the weak became stronger. More importantly, he helped us to see that God was with us. In the midst of all the hurt and pain, **God** is continuing to see us through.

It warmed our hearts to see the thousands of people from all over western New York and further, coming into our community to help. It was equally heartwarming to see residents who didn't have much in common with each other, coming to the aid of their neighbors. We, at Urban Christian Ministries, are so, so proud to be a part of this community! Not only have we been located on Jefferson Ave for over 30 years, many of our staff live here, or have grown up in this community. For us, *THIS IS HOME!* Though we have done yard sale give aways for over 20 years on Jefferson, this incident made this year's give away much more personal. Yard sale give away is simply a yard sale where everything is free. We collected a **record** amount of what we call "good junk".



Over the years, we normally served 150 families, but due to the overwhelming amount of donations this year, we served over 350 families. Everyone not only left with good junk, they left with "GREAT STUFF". We had washers, dryers, stoves, refrigerators, table & chairs, tons of small appliances, flat screen televisions, beds, dressers, clothing for men, women and children, and so much more. It was truly a pleasure to serve God by serving His people.

To everyone who stopped what they were doing to raise money, collect food, and all the labors of love that was poured out into our community, **JESUS SAID**, "IN AS MUCH AS YOU HAVE DONE THIS TO THE LEAST OF THESE MY BROTHERS, YOU HAVE DONE IT UNTO ME". Matthew 25:40

All the individuals who donated or volunteered at the yard sale give away by picking up truck loads of furniture and moving stuff (the day of) from the garage, the basement, the front room, and our conference room.
